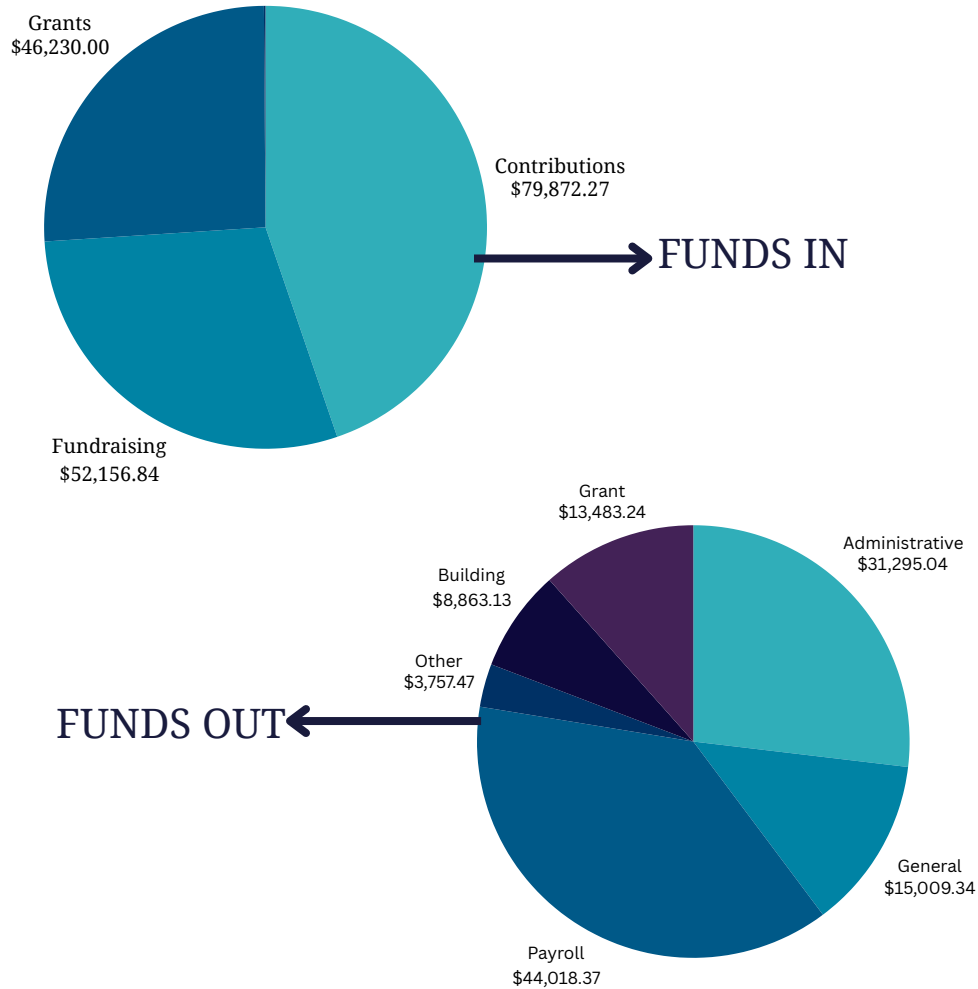
IMPACT GROWTH

One of the most exciting areas of growth for Sojourn House in 2022 was the sheer amount of classes and conversations our **Outreach Case Manager, Kim**, has had with women in our area. Kim has offered **26 classes** and a total of **37 women** have attended.

One of the first aspects of the class is simply defining trafficking. One attendee of the class sadly understood that she had been trafficked, yet, **she thanked** Kim for having the class stating, "**Nobody understands what I am talking about.**" This class gives language to the women that have been taken advantage of and trafficked.

It has become clear through the women taking these classes with Kim that **trafficking is still very present** with some of the most vulnerable of women **in our own community**. We are confident that as Kim keeps educating, these women will feel the hope and change that is possible at Sojourn House.
